Conditions

1. Each applicant must submit an itinerary detailing the departments he or she wishes to visit.
2. The duration of the programme must be such as to include at least 10 working days (of which the first and last days may be counted) and should involve visits to departments in other countries that are members of EFOMP.
3. Applicants must be members of an EFOMP affiliated organisation, must be under 35 years on the date of application and must have been working as a medical physicist in either a hospital, university or research institute engaged in similar work for a period of at least four years.
4. **All sections of the application form must be completed** and submitted to the Honorary Secretary of the respective National Organisation for ratification. However, applicants are strongly advised to send a copy of their application to the to the EFOMP Registered Office, at the address below in case the original application is delayed:
